



## Becoming an STA Tutor by APL



The STA has a number of different tutor types linked to the various STA qualifications - swimming teaching, baby & pre-school, special needs, Aquacise, etc.

STA Tutors are also registered as examiners for the same status. There are no additional costs to become a Tutor but all Tutors must be members of the STA. Tutors are moderated on a periodic basis, normally every 2 to 3 years and the moderation fee currently fixed at £95 is payable by the Tutor. Examiners are also moderated; there is no charge for this.

Tutors from other organisations with equivalent qualifications are eligible to be registered as STA Tutors by completing this form and supplying copies of the relevant certificates. This will be processed, normally within 7 days, and you will be asked to confirm your acceptance and agree to abide by the relevant Rules and Regulations; on receipt of this by the STA your certificate will be issued.
