#### **Pre-requisites**

- Be of 17 years of age or older
- Hold current membership with STA
- Hold the STA Award in Pool Emergency Procedures or acceptable equivalent
- Hold the STA Award in Swimming Teaching or acceptable equivalent
- Hold either the STA Safeguarding Children, Young People and Vulnerable Adults certificate (available online at www.trainsta.co.uk) or acceptable equivalent.

#### Validity of Award

This qualification does not expire.

#### Length of Course

70 Notional Learning Hours:

- 28 Recommended Guided Learning Hours
- 42 Non-contact Guided Learning Hours.

#### **Course Information**

#### The STA Certificate in Swimming Teaching covers:

- Teaching Swimming, Lifesaving and Survival Techniques
- Understanding How to Develop Participants Through Coaching Sport
- Understanding the Fundamentals of Coaching Sport.

#### Assessment

The assessment criteria are as follows:

- Complete a portfolio and worksheet questions to the satisfaction of the course tutor
- Undertake poolside teaching during the course
- As part of an external assessment, teach a 20 minute lesson to 6 pupils
- Complete a 100 question multiple-choice paper with unit pass marks of 15/20, 15/20 and 45/60.

#### Revalidation

This qualification does not require revalidation. However, STA recommends all members attend or complete CPDs to continuously update their knowledge and skills.
