Adopted in over 22 countries worldwide, STA's Professional Swimming Teaching qualifications and International Learn to Swim Programme (ILSP) are designed specifically for swimming teachers.

As a result of a UK Government initiative all STA's Swimming Teaching, Lifesaving and Pool Plant qualifications have now been unitised. A crucial part of these reforms was transferring from the National Qualifications Framework to the new QCF (The Qualifications and Credit Framework) which recognises skills and qualifications by awarding credit for qualifications and units (small steps of learning).

Accordingly, all STA's Swimming Teaching, Lifesaving and Pool Plant qualifications have now been approved and accredited by Ofqual, which ensures their quality.

For STA's Swimming Teaching Qualifications specifically, this means they:

- Sit on the new QCF Register at Level 2 with Ofqual
- Qualify for Framework Apprenticeship Funding
- Offer the most cost effective and time efficient route to qualify as an aquatic professional.

STA Level 2 Award in Swimming Teaching (QCF) (7 credits - no expiry date)

Holders of this Award can teach up to 10 beginners. They may deliver the STAnley Series of awards and also the Octopus and Goldfish Series of STA's International Learn to Swim Programme.

Holders of this Award may also act as an assistant swimming teacher and may teach larger classes or advanced skills under the direct supervision of a swimming teacher qualified to certificate level.

STA Level 2 Certificate in Swimming Teaching (QCF) (17 credits - no expiry date)

Holders of this Certificate can teach, without supervision, pupils of all levels.

STA Level 2 Award in Aquatic Teaching – Baby and Pre-school

(to be credited in December 2012 - no expiry date)

The only qualification on the National Qualifications Framework that qualifies Baby & Pre-school Teachers in the special skills required to introduce babies and very young children to aquatic activities.
