

Membership of the Swimming Teachers' Association is available to all who are interested in the charitable objectives of the STA, the preservation of human life by teaching swimming, lifesaving and survival techniques. Applicants for membership of STA do not have to be qualified with STA; STA recognises qualifications from many other organisations in the UK and overseas. Membership is mandatory for candidates enrolling on most STA courses and is mandatory for all Tutors.

Applying for Membership

Applications for membership should:

- Complete the Membership Application Form overleaf, and
- Either complete the Direct Debit Mandate overleaf OR enclose a cheque for the full fees, and
- Indicate overleaf the category of membership required, and
- Produce the required documents as set out overleaf, and
- Send the documentation to STA as set out overleaf (address below).

Gift Aid Declaration

Members' subscriptions can be paid as a Gift Aid; this benefits STA but incurs no further cost to the member. If you do not comply with item 2 below, or you do not wish your subscription to be included, tick the "Gift Aid Declaration" box located on the front page of this application form.

1. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
