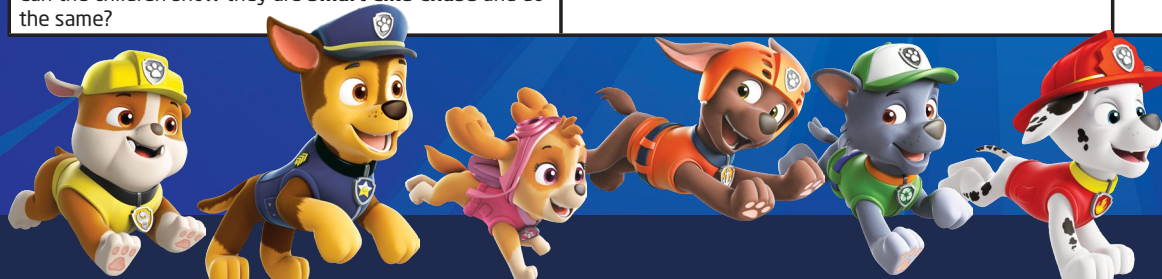


# ALL PAWS IN FOR INTERNATIONAL LEARN TO SWIM WEEK 2024

## LET'S LEARN THE WATER SAFETY CODE WITH PAW PATROL

Activity	Teaching practices	Teachers tips
<p>Zuma wants to go for a swim. Before he does though what does Zuma need to do?</p> <p>Highlight the dangers that children need to look out for.</p> <p>Skye has offered to help us <b>spot the dangers</b>. She's up in her helicopter from above keeping an eye out.</p>	<p>Before children get in the pool ask them what type of things they could find in the water. Who can they find in the water in Adventure Bay? What else?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Zuma is the playful pup and is all about the water</li> <li>• Children can answer about the creatures that swim in adventure bay then move onto dangerous such as rocks, deep water, items in the water etc.</li> <li>• PAW Patrol answers: Wally the Walrus, Giant Octopus, Giant Sea Slug, The Flounder etc.</li> <li>• <b>Let's Be Determined Like Skye</b> to find the dangers we need to be aware of!</li> </ul>
<p>Zuma <b>shouldn't swim alone</b>, who should we get to join him?</p> <p>Let's get all the pups to come and <b>Be Playful Like Zuma!</b></p>	<p>Use questions to ask if children should swim alone?</p> <p>Explain why we don't swim alone.</p> <p>Who should we wait for?</p>	<p>Ask children which pup is their favourite to join us.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Skye</li> <li>• Zuma</li> <li>• Chase</li> <li>• Marshall</li> <li>• Rubble</li> <li>• Rocky</li> </ul>
<p>All the pups have come out to play. But clumsy Marshall has fell in the water before he was ready!</p> <p><b>Let's be brave like Marshall</b> and <b>float</b> while the other pups get help.</p>	<p>Go through all the different floats and try and encourage children to hold them for longer.</p> <p>Once children are holding their floats ask them to <b>shout for help</b>.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Marshall is the clumsy pup but he's also brave, can the children <b>Be Brave Like Marshall?</b></li> </ul>
<p>Rubble saw Marshall fall in and he wants to help. <b>Let's be Helpful like Rubble</b> and <b>call for help!</b></p>	<p>Should Rubble jump in after Marshall to help?</p> <p>Explain why he shouldn't jump in but what else he can do to help. Who can Rubble call?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 999</li> <li>• Adult</li> <li>• Lifeguard</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask the children if they know who 999 calls and if they know which pup works with emergency services:</li> <li>PAW Patrol answer: Chase (police dog)</li> <li>• Can you point out the lifeguard? What colours do lifeguards wear?</li> </ul>
<p>Rocky wants to try and find something that he can throw to Marshall to help him float.</p>	<p>Throw toys in the pool and ask the children to <b>Be PAW-sitive Like Rocky</b> and try and find some items to help Marshall:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• See if children understand what items float and sink and get them to test the items</li> <li>• See if children can swim across the pool or float with a ball</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rocky is a pup who always has handy resources and likes to recycle the things he finds into useful items</li> </ul>
<p><b>Summary</b></p> <p>Marshall is safe and now the pups can enjoy their swim knowing the <b>water safety code</b> and how to stay safe by the water.</p> <p>Can the children show they are <b>Smart Like Chase</b> and do the same?</p>	<p>Marshall is safe, what does Marshall always say when he's been clumsy?</p> <p>Summarise the lesson with the children by asking questions to see what they have learnt.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chase is the natural leader of the group, can the children to <b>Be Smart Like Chase</b>, and tell us the <b>water safety code?</b></li> <li>• Marshall always says, "I'm okay!"</li> </ul>



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
