The press statement read "one drowning is tragic but 15 in the matter of a few weeks is very serious" - read more.

Get PTLLS Online

Due to new government regulations, **all** new and existing STA Swimming Teaching, Lifesaving and First Aid Tutors and/or Examiners will be required to hold a **PTLLS** certificate in order to continue Tutoring and Examining from **1st January 2014**.

A step-by-step guide has been provided for existing tutors who qualified before 1st January 2013 to obtain the certificate via Recognised Prior Learning (RPL) through STA Online. The cost of this conversion is £10 and must be taken before 31st December 2013. **Click here** to download the RPL guide, or **click here** to be taken to STA Online.
