Tutor Pre-Requisites

<p>Aquatic Tutor Course:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be at least 19 years of age. • Hold a current STA Membership. • Hold a minimum of Level 3 Award in Education and Training qualification or acceptable equivalent. • Hold a valid aquatic teaching qualification in the chosen discipline* for a minimum of 2 years. • Provide evidence of at least 200 hours of teaching in the chosen discipline. • Hold a Safeguarding Children, Young People and Vulnerable Adults or acceptable equivalent. <p><i>*STA Certificate in Swimming Teaching, STA Baby & Pre-School Swimming, STA Open Water Coaching, STA People with Disabilities (or acceptable equivalents).</i></p>
<p>Lifesaving Tutor Course:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be at least 19 years of age. • Hold a current STA Membership. • Hold a minimum of the Level 3 Award in Education and Training or acceptable equivalent. • Hold the Pool Lifeguard or Pool Emergency Responder qualification or acceptable equivalent (please note that learners who only hold a Pool Emergency Responder will not be able to deliver Pool Lifeguarding courses) • Have occupational competence showing experience working within the leisure industry as a pool lifeguard or health club attendant.
<p>Pool Lifeguard Tutor Conversion Course:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be at least 19 years of age. • Hold a current STA Membership. • Hold a minimum of Level 3 Award in Education and Training qualification or acceptable equivalent. • Hold a Lifeguarding Tutor qualification (please supply a copy of your certificate. • Current First Aid Certificates. • Provide a portfolio of evidence detailing what you have taught over the past two years.

Pool Plant Tutor Course:

- Be at least 19 years of age.
- Hold a current STA Membership.
- Hold the [Pool Plant Operations qualification](#) or acceptable equivalent.
- Please also record a 10-minute micro teach of yourself completing a pool water test demonstration for free chlorine, total chlorine and pH discussing key teaching points and best practice. This video along with your CV and cover letter will be used to determine your suitability for the course.

Please ensure you meet the criteria in the person specification fully and have the specialist subject matter knowledge, understanding and experience to be able to deliver the content before booking. The tutor course is not intended to teach the technical content of the discipline, the course focuses on training learners how to tutor and assess STA's qualifications to our expected standards abiding with STA's policies and procedures.

Please be aware that you will be assessed on your technical knowledge and understanding during your presentations. Therefore, it is essential you have the specialist technical knowledge, understanding and experience in the discipline. Only if your technical knowledge and understanding is deemed satisfactory during your presentations will you be granted probationary tutor status, if deemed NOT to have sufficient technical knowledge and understanding to tutor to STA's expected standards you will NOT be granted tutor status.
