STA Score Big Again, With A NPS Score of 84%

In 2020 during the height of the pandemic, we conducted our first Net Promoter Score® (NPS) which exceeded all expectations with a way above industry average score of 84%. Three years on, in June, we carried out a second NPS customer survey and it's been confirmed that we achieved the same impressive score of 84% - with 87% of customers scoring STA's products and services a 9 or a 10. For context, only around 10% of UK brands get an NPS of 40% or more! Thanks to everyone who participated.

Go Sophie!

That was the message on Monday 21st August when Sophie Etheridge, the Founder of Adaptive and Disabled Open Water Swimmers (ADOWS), started on her journey to become the first person with Complex Regional Pain Syndrome to swim the English Channel solo. Joining her as crew was STA's Ambassadors Mike Goody and Camilla Golledge (who supported her in and out of the water, and who afterwards Sophie said had got her through some really rough waters on the second night).

We all closely followed the swim, willing her on, and we were in constant contact with Mike so that we could post updates on socials. Fast forward **29 hours and 4 minutes** (time to be officially verified), and we got the call at 5.30am to say 'she's done it' and that Sophie had not only achieved her ambition but she had also set a new World Record for her time.

As posted on socials, the whole of the STA team is incredibly proud of Sophie, and what she has achieved for disability swimming is groundbreaking. Her sole purpose for this swim was not to break records, but to raise awareness of open water swimmers with disabilities and show what those with disabilities can achieve with the correct support and people around them. Sophie definitely did that and we cannot wait to hear more

when she speaks at the **STA conference** in October. In the meantime, **please continue to show your support here.**




Four-Year-Old Becomes the Youngest to Join our Roll of Honour
