It is utterly devasting for the families, the community and for all the emergency teams that tried desperately to save them, and we would like to offer our deepest condolences. This tragedy has also sparked an outburst from every charitable organisation involved in water safety, and together we are calling for the government to not only listen but take the lead on water safety education in schools – something we have all been calling upon for years but to no avail and is why we have all been committed to campaigning through our own annual charity events like International Learn to Swim Week. After witnessing the tragedies in Solihull, we have to do more, but it needs to be government-led and off the back of #STAmpOutVAT, we have proactively reached out to MPs and meetings are being organised in Westminster for the New Year.
