New Safety Award For Teachers

Earlier this month, we updated the Safety Award for Teachers qualification. The new qualification will replace STA's current STA Award in Safety Award for Teachers and is titled STA Level 2 Award for Safety Award for Teachers (STA SAT).

Kaylë Brightwell, Head of Qualification Development, confirmed there have been no significant changes to the technical content, however, the qualification unit has been updated following research and feedback to include the management of a simulated emergency situation as well as common aquatic first aid skills.

The qualification's supporting resources have also been updated and rebranded to reflect these changes and are available to download from STA Online.
