STA's Level 2 Award - Dispelling the Myths

Today, STA still remains the only Awarding Organisation to offer two Level 2 swimming teaching qualifications, and the latest figures from Ofqual, show that STA delivered 50% of all the Level 2 CIMSPA-endorsed swimming teaching qualifications in England in 2022, with 100% of our teachers able to directly teach on poolside and having an impact on millions of people's lives.

IN A NEW BLOG Kaylë Brightwell, STA's Director of Education talks specifically about the Award in Teaching Swimming; why the qualification was developed and why because of its uniqueness, it can sometimes be misunderstood as there is nothing 'traditional' to compare it to. It's NOT a Level 1 Teaching Assistant qualification and it's NOT a Level 2 Certificate in Teaching Swimming qualification, so Kaylë delves deeper to dispel any myths.
