ILSW – Record Year for Participation!

The month of May can only mean one thing in our calendar - International Learn to Swim Week - and this year it was our biggest campaign to date with a total of 34 countries taking part with more than 588,000 participants learning how to #LoveWaterSafely. Thank you to everyone who got involved, and as our President, Ali Beckman said at the end of the week, keep sharing the resources and spreading the importance of water safety education through the summer months.

New Survey - Children Missing Out on the Benefits of Swimming

To mark the start of ILSW, we also published a new national survey which revealed that a third of parents are having trouble accessing regular swimming lessons because of the current swimming teacher shortage - and the cost of living is also having an impact on extra-curricular activities. This was featured extensively across the broadcast media

during the week, reaching more than 57 million people, which also allowed us to promote the importance of #STAndUpforSwimming.
