Record Year for International Learn to Swim Week

Thanks to everyone who played a part in this year's International Learn to Swim Week, which we first launched in 2017 with the theme of #LoveWaterSafely. In this time, the awareness campaign has grown year on year (even through the pandemic), and many hundreds of thousands of venues have taken part to raise awareness about the importance of learning to swim and water safety education. This year has been our biggest campaign yet, with half a million children involved across 40 countries.



New Chapter for Wakefield Council

STAnd out at this Year's Conference



Respect the Water

This month the latest downing statistics from the Water Incident Database (WAID) were published. In response, the National Water Safety Forum (NWSF), of which we are a member, responded by urging the public to 'Respect The Water' as the latest statistics show that there were sadly 226 accidental drownings in 2022, with more dying at inland water than at the coast. In line with this, the RNLI also began its annual #FloatToLive campaign. During this year's International Learn to Swim Week, the core message was to #LoveWaterSafely All Year Round, and knowing how to Respect The Water, Float to Live, and help other people in trouble is an essential part of this safety message.
